Lodging and Travel Expenses for Clinical Rotations

Estimated Costs Related to Clinical Rotations

Students in the Physician Assistant Program complete supervised clinical practice experiences (SCPEs) at affiliated clinical sites across multiple regions. While some sites are located near campus, others require travel.

Based on the program's current clinical site distribution and historical placement patterns, the **typical student should expect to complete approximately two clinical rotations that require travel away from the campus area**. To provide transparency regarding potential expenses, the program includes an estimated cost for travel and temporary housing associated with these rotations.



Item	Typical Assumption
Away rotations	2 rotations
Housing	\$1200/month × 2 months
Travel	\$300 gas or \$450 airfare × 2 months
