

## Packing List: What to Bring to Indiana State University

### Laundry & Cleaning Supplies

- Broom/vacuum
- Laundry Detergent
- Hangers
- Garbage bags
- Laundry bag or collapsible hamper
- Paper towels

### Cooking & Food

- Dishes & utensils
- Mugs
- Reusable cups
- Reusable microwave safe containers
- Reusable water bottles
- Food items (such as macaroni and cheese, ramen noodles, soup, cereal, crackers etc.)
- Pots & pans (for buildings with kitchens)

### Electronics & Appliances

- Cell phone & charger
- Coffee Maker (no hot plate, must have auto shut-off)\*
- Lamp
- Laptop & charger
- Surge protectors
- TV \*
- Fan \*
- Fridge (3.5 cubic feet/1.5 amp max) \*
- Microwave (Not to exceed 700W)
- Microfridge (microwave/fridge combo unit)

### Documents & Payment

- Driver's license
- University ID
- Credit Card
- Emergency contact numbers
- Work Documents(if planning to work on-campus; Birth certificate, social security card, etc.)

### Linens

- Bath Towels
- Bedding & blankets
- Pillows & Pillow Cases
- Washcloths
- Sheets (Twin XL Sheets)

### Toiletries

- Comb, brush
- Hairdryer, flat irons
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Shampoo/conditioner
- Hand soap
- Hand sanitizer
- Emergency health kit
- Personal thermometer

### Miscellaneous

- Medications
- Command strips
- Posters, decorations
- Flip flops or shower shoes
- Toilet paper (for those with private bath)
- Backpack
- School supplies: notebooks, binders, pencils, calculator, pens, highlighters
- Umbrella
- Small lock-box for prescriptions & other valuables
