Revise the Constitution of the Faculty of the Indiana State University to accurately reflect current unit structure.

Background of Issue:

Changes occur throughout section 145 of the Constitution. The College of Graduate and Professional Studies and University College no longer exist. The Library no longer exists as a college-equivalent subdivision.

145.1.2 Definition of University Faculty. All appointees with academic rank ~~and the professional librarians~~ shall constitute the regular faculty of Indiana State University.

145.3.1.1.4 ~~College of Graduate and Professional Studies, University College, and Honors College.~~ The ~~College of Graduate and Professional Studies, the University College and the~~ Honors College ~~are not~~ ~~is not~~ a coordinate academic subdivisions in this sense and ~~are~~ ~~is~~ not entitled to separate representation in the University Faculty Senate.

145.5.2 Jurisdiction Relative to the College/Library. When a college/library of the University, through its legislative body, protests an action of the University Faculty or the University Faculty Senate as encroaching on the autonomy of a college/library, the University Faculty Senate shall reconsider the question. The University Faculty Senate shall determine the issue unless the legislative body of the college/library appeals from this decision of the University Faculty Senate and the University Faculty. In such event, the Secretary of the University Faculty Senate shall call a meeting of the University Faculty and conduct a subsequent vote as provided in Sections 145.1.4 and 145.1.5.

145.6.2.1 Faculty Grievances. A member of the University Faculty or a group of faculty members may bring a grievance not falling within the authority of a college/library directly to the Executive Committee of the University Faculty Senate or may appeal a grievance to the Executive Committee after avenues of relief within the college/library affected have been exhausted.

145.7.1.3 Representation. The members represent the University Faculty, not the college/~~library~~ to which they may belong, and no college/~~library~~ is as such entitled to representation on a standing committee.

145.8 Relationship with College/~~Library~~ Governance Bodies

145.8.1 Representative Governance. The faculty of the colleges/~~library~~ are guaranteed a representative form of governance in respect to the formulation and administration of internal policy and the right to participate in the selection of their chief administrative officers.

145.8.1.1 Selection of Administrative Officers. Similarly, the faculty of each academic subdivision of the colleges/~~library~~ are guaranteed the right to participate in the selection of its administrative officer.

145.8.2 Plan of Internal Governance. Within one (1) year following the adoption of this Constitution, each existing college/~~library~~ shall submit to the University Faculty Senate an acceptable plan of internal governance consistent with this Constitution and bylaws.

145.8.2.1 New College. Within one (1) year of the establishment of any new college, it shall submit to the University Faculty Senate an acceptable plan of internal governance consistent with this Constitution and Bylaws.

(Constitutions of the colleges/~~library~~ have been approved/amended by the University Faculty Senate on the dates as indicated: College of Arts and Sciences – April, 2000; College of Business – April, 1998; College of Education – Fall, 1992; College of Health and Human Performance – May, 1996; College of Nursing – April, 2000; College of Technology – March, 1986; ~~Library Faculty – April, 2003.~~)

145.8.3 Autonomy of the Colleges/~~Library~~. Each college/~~library~~ shall be autonomous in matters of internal policy, subject to the provisions of its constitution and bylaws and to actions of the University faculty and the University Faculty Senate pursuant to this Constitution and bylaws.

~~**145.8.4 College of Graduate and Professional Studies.** The faculty of the College of Graduate and Professional Studies, being already members of the faculties of their respective academic units, shall not as a graduate faculty have a representative form of governance. The policies of this College are determined by the Graduate Council of the University Faculty Senate subject to approval of the University Faculty Senate. The College of Graduate and Professional Studies is, therefore, excluded from the autonomy provided by this Constitution.~~

146.2.2.1.2 Training. The Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs, in cooperation with ~~the Office of Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion and the Executive Committee~~ Faculty Senate Chairperson, will provide formal annual training in mediation and grievance procedures to ~~of~~ the Grievance Pool members ~~in mediation and grievance procedures annually.~~ All persons selected to serve as Grievance Pool members in a given cycle must participate in Training.

146.2.1.2.2.3.1 Search Committee Membership Nominations. Upon notification by the Chairperson of the University Faculty Senate, the Administrative and Economic Affairs Committee shall generate a pool of at least (15) fifteen faculty that represent all Academic Colleges, all ranks of the regular faculty, and the ethnic and gender composition of the faculty. This pool will be created by the Administrative and Economic Affairs Committee after a formal call for nominations by the committee to all regular faculty. From that pool, the Administrative and Economic Affairs Committee shall nominate two slates (without overlap) to serve on the presidential or academic vice presidential search committees. The pool and the two slates will be forwarded to the Executive Committee of the University Faculty Senate for approval by the University Faculty Senate.

146.2.1.2.2.3.1.1 Role of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate will review the two slates to ensure the search committee is broadly representative of the University faculty, and recommend one or both of the slates to the Faculty Senate. ~~If the Executive Committee rejects both slates, it shall compose a third slate from the faculty pool generated by the Administrative and Economic Affairs Committee.~~

146.2.1.2.2.3.1.2 Role of the Faculty Senate. The Faculty Senate will act on the recommendation of the Executive Committee. If the Executive Committee has recommended more than one slate, an immediate single vote will be held between the

two slates, with the one generating the higher number of votes to approve being adopted.

If the Executive Committee has recommended one of the original slates, but not the other, the Senate will vote to approve or reject this slate. If it is rejected, an immediate, single vote will be held between the two ~~Administrative and Economic Affairs~~ slates, with the slate generating the highest number of votes being the Senate's recommended slate.

~~If the Executive Committee has composed and recommended a third slate, an immediate, single vote will be held among the three slates, with the slate generating the highest number of votes being the Senate's recommended slate. If no slate receives a majority of the vote, a run-off vote will be held with the slate generating the higher number of votes being the Senate's recommended slate.~~ The Chairperson of the Faculty Senate shall communicate the approved slate to the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees or the University President (or their designees).

Daniel and Sue Reinhard Family - Safety, Health, and Environment Lab. The naming honors a \$257,000 gift from E. Dan Reinhard in support of the Safety Management program, which will soon be renamed the Safety, Health, and Environment program, and scholarships for students in the Bailey College of Engineering and Technology.

Background of Issue: Dan Reinhard, a 1968 graduate of Indiana State University, was born and raised in Terre Haute. After spending three years in pharmacy school, he returned to Indiana State in search of a different career path. Recognizing his strong background in science, a professor introduced him to a new program in environmental health. Dan became the program's first student, which led to his selection as its first co-op/internship participant. That experience launched a distinguished 34-year career with the U.S. Navy.

After a decade conducting environmental, safety, and occupational health surveys across the Navy and Marine Corps, Dan served two years as Special Assistant to the Navy Surgeon. He was then appointed as the first Director of Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health for the Secretary of the Navy, a role he held on the Secretary's staff for 23 years.

Following his retirement, Dan was recruited to develop a program supporting Secretary Rumsfeld's initiative to reduce fatalities and non-combat mishaps across the Department of Defense. He proposed the creation of the Defense Safety Oversight Council and served as its principal subject matter expert for 13 years before retiring once again.

This new scholarship aims to prepare future professionals to safeguard employees' lives across a wide range of workplaces nationwide.

Funding Source: The donor has committed a cash pledge of \$257,000.

Supporting Reasons and Timing for the Recommendation: The gift amount for this naming opportunity is consistent with the Indiana State University Naming Policy.

Potential Concerns Arising from the Recommendation and Steps Needed to Address Them: No known concerns.

Management Recommendation: Leadership recommends approval of the naming of Room 221 in the newly renovated Bailey College of Engineering and Technology the E. Daniel and Sue Reinhard Family - Safety, Health, and Environment Lab.

Objective: Approval of the proposed 2026-27 General Fund, Line-Item, and Auxiliary and Other Operations operating budgets and Student Activity allocations as shown in the attached Exhibits.

Background of Issue:

The General Fund operating budget (Exhibit I) includes all direct costs of instruction as well as most administrative functions, including salary and fringe benefits, utility costs, and university provided student aid. The General Fund budget is supported by two major revenue streams: state appropriations and student tuition.

The State of Indiana provides a separate appropriation, known as fee replacement, to offset the principal and interest on student fee bonds used to finance academic facility projects authorized by the General Assembly, reviewed by the Commission for Higher Education, and approved by the State Budget Committee. Institutions are required to issue debt associated with these facilities and pledge student tuition dollars as repayment. The State then replaces the pledged tuition through a fee replacement or debt service appropriation. The payment of fee-replaced and non-fee replaced academic debt service is included as a direct expense line in the General Fund budget offset by the Academic Debt Service appropriation and other income in the revenue section of the budget.

A portion of student tuition is allocated to operating units within Designated and Auxiliary fund groups to support activities and related programs (Exhibit II). The funds are primarily used to offset operating costs for those units supported by these allocations.

Line-item appropriations and Dual Credit funding (Exhibit III) are received by the State of Indiana to support specific programs. Indiana State University is responsible for two line-item appropriations: Degree Link and Nursing Support. The Dual Credit appropriation is based on a State formula rather than a flat appropriated amount.

The proposed General Fund and Line-Item summary budgets and Student Activity allocations for 2026-27 are prepared with the following key planning assumptions:

- State Operating Appropriation as contained in HEA 1001 (2025) - does not change for 2026-27.
- Fee Replacement Appropriation – increase of \$95,478 corresponding to the FY27 required payments for debt service on state funded capital projects.
- Student Tuition – no increase in resident undergraduate or graduate student tuition. A 5% increase in non-resident undergraduate and graduate student tuition.
- Salaries and Wages – a \$1.6M salary and benefit pool for faculty and staff with distribution to be determined.
- Health Insurance – a 5% increase based on current medical trends and projected health claims expenditures.

- Utilities – increase of \$1.4M to better align the budget with projected actual expenditures based on growing utility costs.
- Other Committed Expense – increase in property and general liability insurance of \$1.1M to better align projected expenditures with the budget.

Auxiliaries are operated as independent units supporting students and the University in various capacities. Residential Life is the largest University auxiliary unit. Each of the Auxiliary units generates outside revenues to support the individual operating budget of the unit. The financial planning components for the General Fund Operating budget were also used in the preparation of Auxiliary budgets (Exhibit IV).

Funding Source: Operating budgets are funded by appropriations from the State of Indiana, student tuition and fees, room and board, and miscellaneous revenue items.

Supporting Reasons and Timing for the Recommendation: Approval of the 2026-27 Operating Budgets is needed to begin financial operations, effective July 1, 2026.

Potential Concerns Arising from the Recommendation and Steps Needed to Address Them:
None

Management Recommendation: The 2026-27 Operating Budgets and Student Activity allocations be approved as presented and authorizing the President of Indiana State University to establish salaries and wages within the capabilities of budgeted resources.

Objective: The Board of Trustees approves the sale of Series U, Student Fee Bonds.

Background of Issue: Indiana State University has several outstanding Student Fee Bonds (SFB), namely Series T, S, R, Q, and N, totaling a par value of \$95 million as of June 30, 2025. These bonds are mainly financed by the State of Indiana through annual fee replacement appropriations, which are set at \$10,498,371 for FY2026 and \$10,593,848 for FY2027.

Three SFBs—Series N, Q, and R—can be called by October 1, 2026, with a combined par amount of approximately \$41 million and interest rates ranging from 3.00% to 6.64%. Given current and future bond market trends, the University expects sufficient cash flow and present value savings to justify issuing the proposed Refunding Series U Bond. The anticipated savings will mostly benefit the State of Indiana by reducing the required fee replacement appropriation.

Earlier this spring, the University sought proposals from several national financial institutions for underwriting and investment banking services. Following the competitive evaluation process, Stifel was selected based on their pricing of services as well as value added to anticipated financing. Additionally, the University utilizes the services of an independent financial advisor on all debt financing – Blue Rose Capital Advisors. Annual principal payments are expected to start on October 1, 2026, and continue each October 1 thereafter.

Funding Source: The Series U Bond issuance will facilitate the redemption and refinancing of multiple outstanding SFB series, consolidating existing debt obligations into a single refunding structure to achieve cost savings and streamline debt service payments.

Supporting Reasons and Timing for the Recommendation: Indiana State is dedicated to being a responsible steward of taxpayer funds. By approving this resolution, the Board enables the University Treasurer to respond promptly when market conditions present the greatest opportunity for savings, benefiting both the institution and taxpayers.

The true interest cost of the Series U Bonds shall not exceed 4.500%, and with such serial or term maturities and redemption features as the executing officers shall approve. The final maturity of the Series Q Bonds shall not extend beyond October 1, 2044. The Series U Bonds shall be sold pursuant to the Bond Purchase Agreement at negotiated sale to an underwriter as selected and appointed pursuant to Section 9 below.

Section 3. The President and the Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all acts and things, to seek all necessary approvals from the State Budget Committee (if necessary) and the State Budget Director of the State of Indiana, and to make and approve all changes in form or substance to the Supplemental Indenture, the Bond Purchase Agreement, the Rebate Agreement, the Undertaking Agreement or the Official Statement necessary to secure approval of the transaction contemplated herein by any rating agency, bond insurer, reserve fund surety bond provider, or the State of Indiana.

Section 4. The Supplemental Indenture, the Bond Purchase Agreement, the Rebate Agreement and the Undertaking Agreement are hereby approved in substantially the forms as may be approved by the Treasurer and is made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein. The President, Treasurer and the Vice President of the University (the “Vice President”), or either of them, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, and the Secretary and the Assistant Secretary of the University (the “Secretary” and the “Assistant Secretary”, respectively), or either of them, are hereby authorized to attest the signature of and to imprint the corporate seal of the University, as applicable, on the Supplemental Indenture, the Bond Purchase Agreement, the Rebate Agreement and the Undertaking Agreement with any changes in form or substance that the President and Treasurer, and the officers executing the Supplemental Indenture, the Bond Purchase Agreement, the Rebate Agreement and the Undertaking Agreement shall approve, such approval to be conclusively evidenced by the execution and delivery thereof.

Section 5. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to approve and make any changes in form or substance to the Official Statement as are necessary or appropriate, to authorize the distribution

of the Official Statement, to deem the Official Statement to be final or nearly final for purposes of applicable Securities and Exchange Commission rules, to execute and deliver the form of any final Official Statement with those changes in form or substance that the Treasurer shall approve, and to cause printed copies of the Preliminary and final Official Statements to be provided to those prospective purchasers, investors and other persons as they may deem advisable in order to market the Series Q Bonds, and any such prior actions are hereby ratified and confirmed. The Official Statement is hereby made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Section 6. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to prepare the bond forms required for use in the issuance of the Series U Bonds, on the terms and conditions set forth in the Supplemental Indenture, and to cause the same to be executed manually or by facsimile by the proper officers of the University as provided in the Supplemental Indenture and the Indenture. Upon execution of the Series U Bonds, the Treasurer shall deliver the Series U Bonds to the Trustee for authentication, and upon their authentication, the Treasurer is authorized and directed to deliver the Series U Bonds to the purchasers thereof on payment of the purchase price, which price shall reflect the underwriters' discount permitted by this Resolution and original issue discount or bond premium, if any, as permitted by law.

Section 7. The Chair, Vice Chair, President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and Assistant Secretary, or any of them acting singly or jointly, are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all further acts and things necessary underlying the execution and delivery of such additional or supporting agreements, documents or certificates as may be requested or necessary in order to complete the transactions contemplated by this resolution, the Bond Purchase Agreement, the Supplemental Indenture, the Rebate Agreement, the Undertaking Agreement and the Official Statement hereby authorized.

Section 8. The Board hereby approves the calculations made by the Treasurer with respect to the coverage factor of Student Fees to Maximum Annual Debt Service after the issuance of the Series U Bonds, all as shown in the Official Statement for the Series U Bonds.

Section 9. The Board hereby ratifies the selection of, and appoints, Stifel as underwriter for the Series U Bonds. The Board hereby ratifies the selection of, and appoints, (i) Ice Miller LLP as bond counsel and special disclosure counsel for the Series U Bonds, and (ii) Blue Rose Capital Advisors as financial advisor for the Series U Bonds.

Section 10. The use of bond insurance is hereby approved in connection with the Series U Bonds, if deemed beneficial to the University in the best judgment of the Treasurer. The Treasurer are hereby authorized to select a bond insurer, if deemed beneficial at their discretion and using their best judgment, and to accept any commitments and execute any agreements which may be necessary or advisable in connection with any such bond insurance for the Series U Bonds.

Section 11. The Board hereby finds that the current refunding of the Refunded Bonds that are supported with fee replacement will benefit the University because (i) a net savings to the University will be effected (including near term cash flow benefits to the University); or (ii) the net present value of principal and interest payments on the Series U Bonds will be less than the net present value of the principal and interest payments on the outstanding Bonds comprising such Refunded Bonds. Further, the Treasurer is hereby authorized to cancel or defer the effectuation of the Plan of Financing as approved by these Resolutions, if they conclude in their discretion that it would be in the best interest of the University to do so based on any combination of national or world events which disrupt the financial markets or substantially change market conditions.

The Series 2026 Bonds shall be sold pursuant to the Bond Purchase Agreement at negotiated sale to an underwriter as selected and appointed pursuant to Section 9 below.

Section 10. The use of bond insurance is hereby approved in connection with the Series 2026 Bonds, if deemed beneficial to the University in the best judgment of the Treasurer. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to select a bond insurer, if deemed beneficial at their discretion and using their best judgment, and to accept any commitments and execute any agreements which may be necessary or advisable in connection with any such bond insurance for the Series 2026 Bonds.

Section 11. The Board hereby finds that the current refunding of the Refunded Bonds will benefit the University because (i) a net savings to the University will be effected; and (ii) the net present value of principal and interest payments on the corresponding Series 2026 Bonds will be less than the net present value of the principal and interest payments on the respective series of Refunded Bonds, or the refunding of the Refunded Bonds will provide near term cashflow benefits to the University. Further, the Treasurer is hereby authorized to cancel or defer the effectuation of the Plan of Financing as approved by these Resolutions, if they conclude in their discretion that it would be in the best interest of the University

to do so based on any combination of national or world events which disrupt the financial markets or substantially change market conditions.

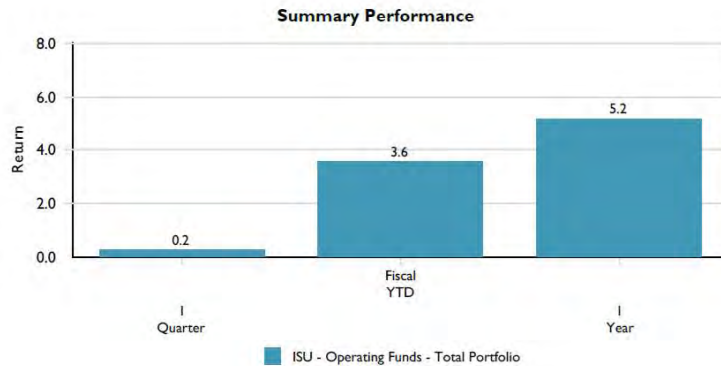
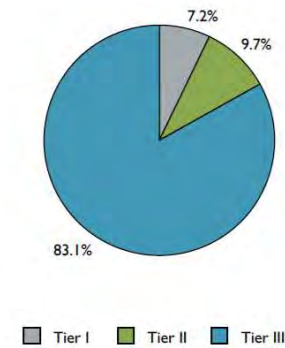

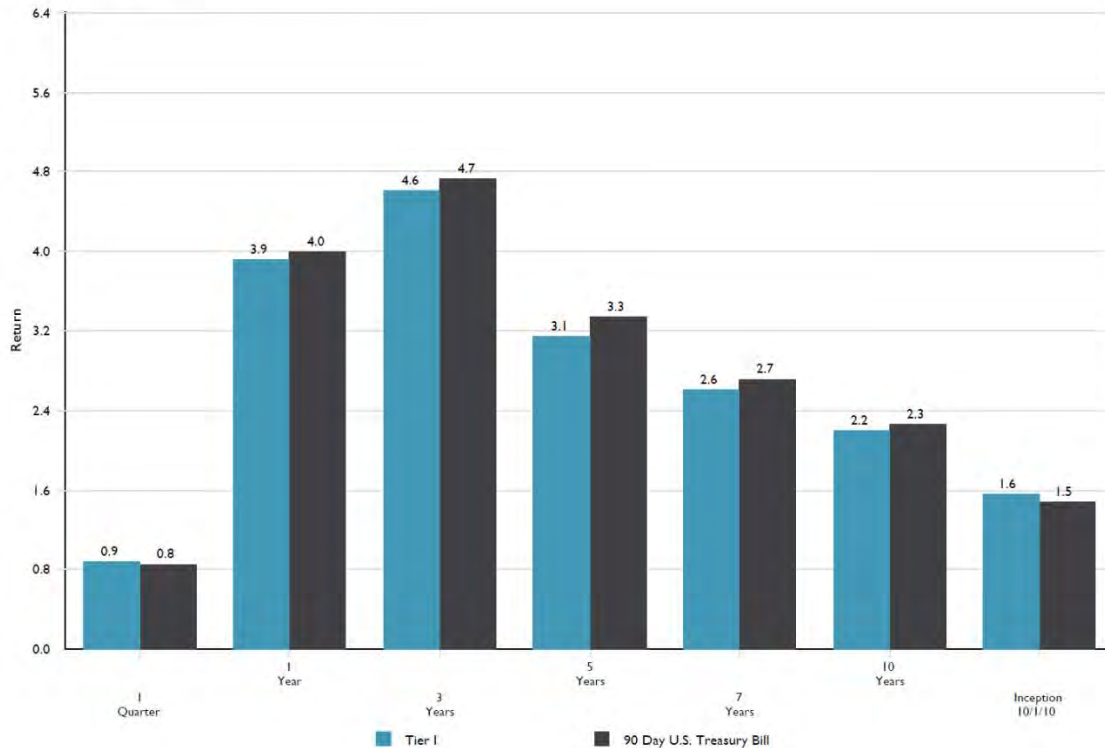
Total Fund Performance - Annualized

As of March 31, 2026



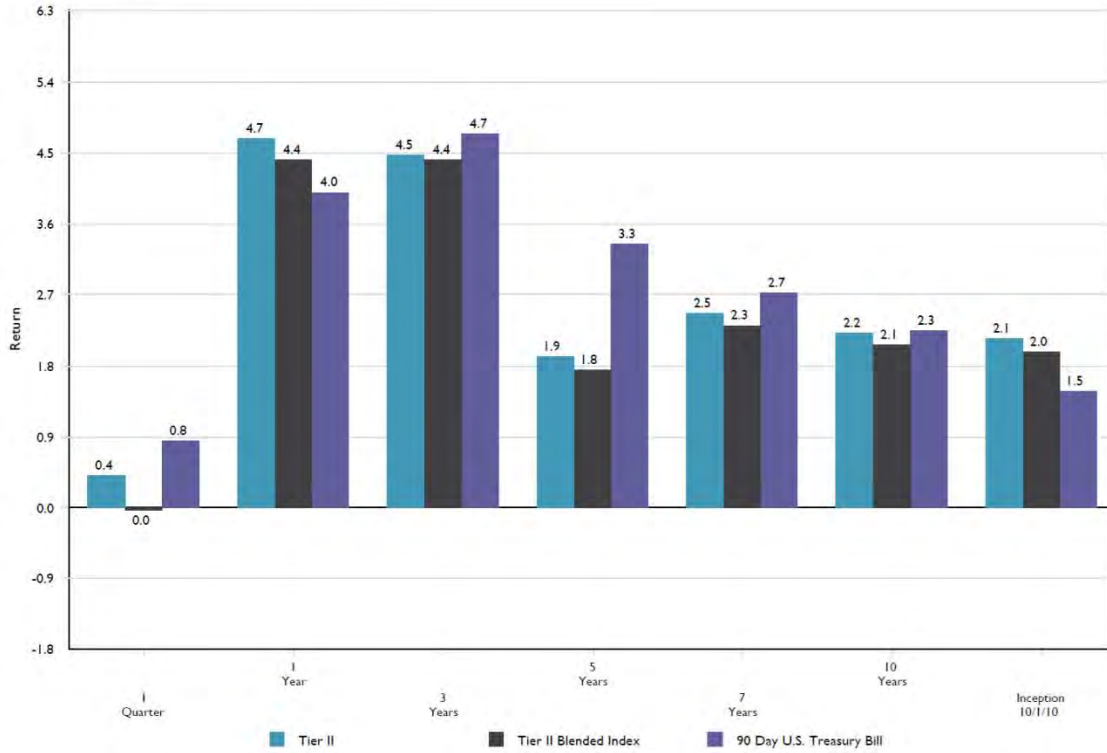
Tier I Performance - Annualized

As of March 31, 2026



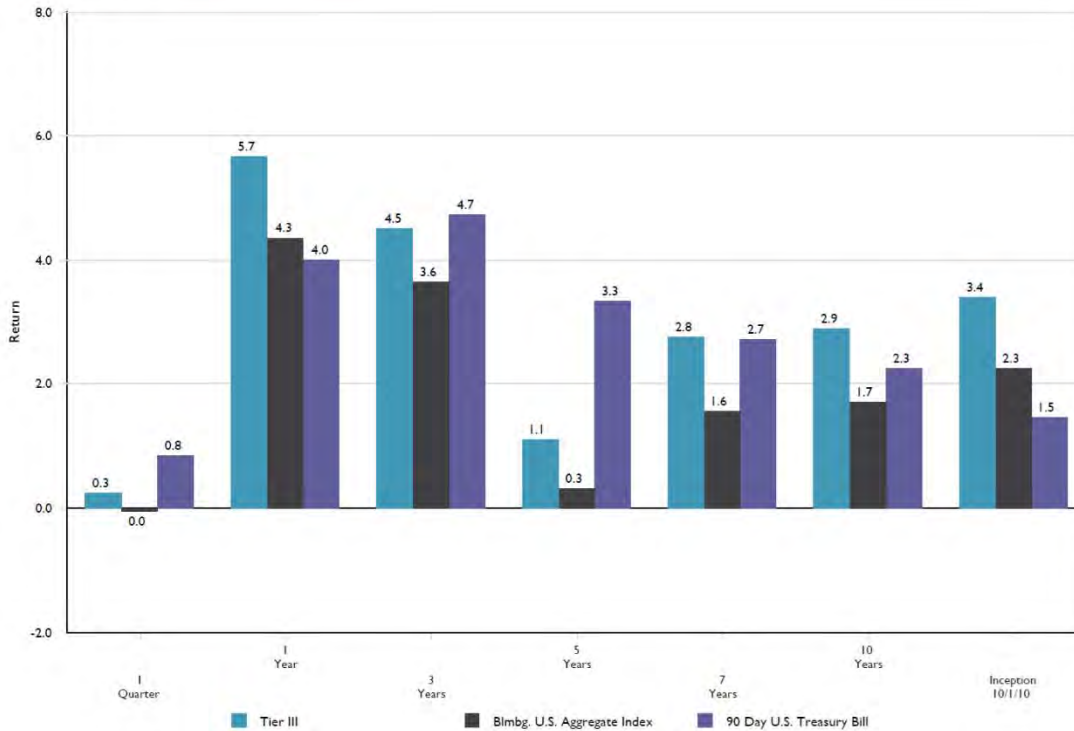
Tier II Performance - Annualized

Revenues

State Operational Appropriation

Indiana State University's State appropriation was cut 5% or \$3.9 million for 2025-26 and is reflected in the reduced base budget of \$74.1 million down from \$78.0 million in 2024-25. Additionally, the State is withholding 5% or \$3.7 million. This withholding will be covered by the carryforward budget designated as Reserve for Revenue shortfall.

Student Tuition

Fall student tuition of \$31.6 million is above budget by \$0.2 million. Spring tuition of \$28.4 million is above budget by \$0.2 million as we continued strong retention between Fall to Spring. Summer school has \$2.9 million recognized in Summer 2025 with the remainder to be realized in Summer 2026.

Other Fees and Charges

Other Fees and Charges are above last year's amount by \$542,472 due to new fees including Business Course, International Fee, and Honors College Fee implemented in the Fall semester and increased Distance Delivery Fees.

Other Income and Transfers

Other Income and Transfers are above last year's total by \$91,499 due to increased Residential Life reimbursement for utilities.

Program Fees

Program fees are above last year's total by \$140,255 due to increased NHHS program fees.

Encumbrances and Carryforward

Encumbrances and Carryforward decreased by \$1.8 million reflecting reduced budget carryforward from 2025.

Reimbursements and Income Reappropriated from Other Sources

Reimbursements and Income Reappropriated from Other Sources increased \$637,625 to reflect increased course fees and OIT transfers from designated funds.

Expenses

Compensation

Total Compensation decreased by \$2.1 million. Salaries and Wages are down by \$2.0 million due to decreased instructional, graduate assistants, and support salaries. Benefit expense are down \$38,094 reflecting decreased salaries and wages offset by increased retirement incentive payouts.

Departmental Expenses

Total Departmental Expenses decreased by \$1,617,086. Supplies and Related Expenses decreased by \$1,954,597, reflecting reduced legal fees, travel expenses, and advertising expenses. Repairs and Maintenance increased by \$143,870, reflecting increased software maintenance partially offset by reduced HVAC expenses. Other Committed Expenses increased by \$193,641 as property insurance premiums have increased and growth in Facilities Management non-contractual services.

Utilities and Related Expenses

Utilities and Related Expenses increased by \$818,170 due to increased electricity and miscellaneous natural gas.

Capital Improvements

The University anticipates carrying forward \$1.9 million of Capital Improvements budget into 2026-27 to cover any State withholding and Capital Improvements.

Student Scholarship and Fee Remissions

Student Scholarship and Fee Remissions shows a decrease of \$1,250,006. This reflects the reduction of the First Year Housing scholarship award amount. The overall budget shortfall for scholarships is estimated at \$1,400,000. A transfer from Residential Life at the end of the fiscal year to cover an estimated \$1,957,000 of Housing scholarships is anticipated.

Budgeted Reserve

The Budgeted Reserve of \$2,300,000 will be used to cover any revenue shortfall and operating expense overages.

Transfers Out and Program Fees

Transfer Out and Program Fees decreased by \$238,698, reflecting reduced Marketing and the Registry transfers partially offset by increased program and course fees.

Reserve for State Withholding

Reserve for State Withholding is earmarked to cover the State withholding of \$3.7 million for 2025-26 fiscal year.
