



YOUR GUIDE TO AVOID A TICKET WHILE PARKING ON CAMPUS!

PARKING IN THE PARKING LOTS

- ALL Faculty, staff and students with a car on campus are required to purchase an ISU parking permit and have it displayed from the rearview mirror at all times.
- If you receive a ticket for 'no permit' and you purchase your permit within 5 days we will waive your ticket (up to 2 tickets) as long as you are in the correct lot. You need to bring your ticket into the office.
- Individuals with Student permits are allowed to park in Student and Student/Staff lots. Individuals with staff permits are allowed to park in Staff and Student/Staff lots. Parking in a staff lot Monday—Friday between the hours of 7 am—5 pm with a student permit will result in a parking ticket for wrong lot. (same applies for staff in student lots).
- Only individuals with PREMIUM permits are allowed to park in Lots 10 & 14.
- Remote Permits allow the individual to ONLY park in lots designated as "REMOTE" or "FREE"- Remote/Free permits cannot park on 4th, 5th, or 6th Streets.
- Yellow curbs, fire lanes, loading zones, landscaping/grass areas and open areas without parking lines are not parking spaces. A vehicle may be ticketed and towed if it is left unattended in these areas.
- Parking at the end of a regular aisle is considered a 'driveway' violation and will result in a ticket and/or tow. Be sure that there are white lines on both sides of your vehicle.
- Parking regulations are enforced at all times. Parking in a staff lot with a student permit is allowed only on weekends, between 5 pm—7 am Monday—Friday or when the campus is CLOSED (i.e. all University Offices are closed)
- If a parking permit becomes lost or stolen, it is your responsibility to file a report and purchase a new permit (\$57 surface permit or \$135 garage/Premium). LOCK YOUR CAR AT ALL TIMES and keep windows rolled up.
- Resale of a parking permit or purchase of a permit from anyone other than Parking Services is a violation and is subject to a \$300 fine and vehicle tow/boot at the owner's expense. Do NOT share your permit or give it to others— all fines received on the permit will be charged to the original purchaser.
- Displaying a lost, stolen, altered or fabricated permit will result in a fine of \$300 and vehicle impoundment at the owner's expense.
- Vehicles parked on University property must have current plates, display a current parking permit, and be in a state of good repair and operable.
- **Handicap spaces require an ISU handicap permit at all times.** The person the permit is registered to must be in the vehicle. **Handicap spaces are enforced at ALL times.**

GUEST PARKING

- Guest permits are available for purchase for \$5/day. Guest parking is also available in the Parking Garage, the North Pay Station Lot, the West Lot. Or the West Fire Lane for \$2/hr.
- Students, staff, and faculty are not considered guests and may not display a visitor pass at any time.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Lack of a convenient space is not a valid excuse for parking in violation of regulations.
- Service vehicle spaces require a special permit at all times.
- Don't ask your friend about parking—ask Parking Services (812-237-8888) for the correct answer.
- Moving a barricade to park in a restricted area will result in your car being towed.
- Vehicle flashers should be reserved for emergencies. Unloading or parking "only for a minute" does not constitute an emergency.
- Chronic Violators are individuals with 5 or more parking tickets (*paid or unpaid*) during the academic year and are subject to boot or tow whenever found in violation.
- Parking Lots C, D and G on the east side of campus are less frequently utilized. Spaces are normally available in these areas at all hours of the day.
- Parking on/adjacent to snow mounds is prohibited—all four tires must be on the flat parking surface and in a valid space.

- Handicap and Security escorts are available—call 812-237-5555 to arrange for an escort.
- Parking on 4th, 5th, or 6th Street requires a permit. Remote & FREE permits are not allowed on 4th, 5th, or 6th Street.
- **YELLOW ZONES = NO PARKING.** Do not park in yellow zones. Any portion of your vehicle in the yellow constitutes a violation. Vehicles may be towed if parked in yellow zones or driveways (Hines/Jones/Reeve area), or red zones.
- If you park on 4th Street, your entire vehicle must be within the white lines. Any portion of your vehicle on the white line or over the line is a violation.
- Do not park on the wrong side of the street (i.e. facing oncoming traffic).
- Do not park in areas that have been barricaded.

TYPES OF PERMITS

Student Parking Permit (\$138)- Allows the user to park in any student lot, remote lot, free lot, or staff/student lot (no staff only lots) on the Indiana State campus (excludes metered, pay or specialty lots/spaces; i.e. Psychology Lot). **Student Parking permits are not allowed in lots designated as “Student Premium” (Lots 10 and 14).** Graduate students, undergraduates, graduate assistants, graduate fellows and all others enrolled shall be defined as student for purposes of vehicle registration.

Garage/Student Permit (\$274) - Allows the permit holder to park in the ISU Parking Garage and any student (excluding Premium Lots 10 and 14), remote, free or staff/student lot (no staff only lots - excludes metered, pay or specialty lots/spaces; i.e. Psychology Lot).

Garage Upper/Student Permit (\$200)- Allows the permit holder to park in the ISU Parking Garage on the upper 2 floors and any student (excluding Premium Lots 10 and 14), remote, free or staff/student lot (no staff only lots - excludes metered, pay or specialty lots/spaces; i.e. Psychology Lot).

Student Premium Parking Permit (\$274) - Upper-class students have the first opportunity to purchase PREMIUM Student Parking permits. Premium permit sales may be opened up to freshmen if supply allows.

Remote Parking Permit (\$38) - Remote parking permits are available for faculty, staff, and students. This permit allows the user to only park in the ISU remote lots and free lots. Remote lots include the Lot D Ext (9th and Eagle behind Lot D), Lot Q (8th and Tippecanoe), Lot K (2nd and Chestnut), and the Baseball Lot (1st and Locust). Free lots include Lot F (7th and Tippecanoe), Lot I (Tippecanoe-under the 3rd Street overpass and Lot N (11th and Chestnut). All remote lots will be open to any Faculty, Staff, or Student. **REMOTE PERMITS ARE NOT allowed to park in on-street parking on 4TH, 5TH, or 6th Streets, Student lots, Student/Staff lots, Staff lots or Premium lots.**

FREE Lot Parking Permit - FREE Lot parking permits are available for faculty, staff, and students. This permit allows the user to only park in the ISU FREE lots. Free lots include the Lot F (7th and Tippecanoe), Lot I (Tippecanoe-under the 3rd Street overpass and Lot N (11th and Chestnut). All FREE lots will be open to any Faculty, Staff, or Student. **FREE PERMITS ARE NOT allowed to park in on street parking on 4TH, 5TH, or 6th Streets, Student lots, Student/Staff lots, Staff lots, Premium lots or Remote lots.** You MUST register your vehicle at no charge with Parking Services to receive a FREE Lot Parking Permit.
