



Are you a parent of a child that receives special education services in an Indiana school? Please consider helping us with our study!

“Special Education Dispute Resolution in Indiana: An Examination of the Etiology of Disputes Between Parents and Schools and the Means for Resolving Them”

This study asks you to complete a survey about your experiences with your child’s special education program and share information about any disputes you have had with the school and how they were handled.

Who? Parents, 18 years of age or older, who live in Indiana and have a child that receives or has received special education services are invited to participate in our study. (Parents that live outside of Indiana and/or do not have a child that receives special education services are not asked to participate)

What do I have to do? Take an 8-10-minute on-line survey and, if you choose, participate in a 45-minute tele-conference interview. Interviews are optional.

Why should I do it? Your input is needed so that we may use our study to improve parent/school collaboration that benefits students with disabilities. There are no other incentives for participation.

Where does the study take place? 100% on-line. You can complete the survey with your phone, or type in the link on your computer. Optional interviews will be done by tele-conference or simply by phone.
