

Mike Godard, Ph.D.

President, Indiana State University

Dr. Mike Godard is the 13th President of Indiana State University, bringing over 25 years of higher education and leadership experience. His distinguished career includes roles as a faculty member, department chair, vice provost, and provost.

Before joining Indiana State University, Dr. Godard served as provost at Southeast Missouri State University since 2019. During his tenure, he efficiently reallocated resources to support new initiatives and guided a strategic planning process with measurable goals and key performance indicators. He also forged public-private partnerships, creating innovative academic programs that addressed regional workforce needs and supported economic development.

Dr. Godard's previous roles include interim provost and chief learning officer, and vice provost for enrollment management and student success at the University of Central Missouri, where he achieved record enrollments and increased student retention rates, ensuring affordability and access for all students.

As a first-generation college graduate, Dr. Godard holds a Ph.D. in Human Bioenergetics from Ball State University, a master's in Exercise Physiology from Adelphi University, and a bachelor's in Exercise Science from Vermont State University - Castleton. Dr. Godard and his wife, Kathryn, live in Terre Haute, Indiana, and are proud parents to their two adult sons, Grant and Lance.
