PROGRAM

The PhD in Instructional Leadership prepares professors, researchers, practice educators, and educational leaders to use and contribute to best practices in teaching and learning. The target audience of the program are learners, at a distance, who come prepared with a master's or advanced practice/clinical doctorate. The program requires the student to successfully complete a minimum of 42 credits of doctoral-level graduate work and to plan and defend a dissertation (18 credits).
