Domain 1: Knowledge for Nursing Practice

Integrates, translates, and applies scientific knowledge as the foundation for ethical practice and decision making in diverse health care settings.

Domain 2: Person Centered Care

Utilize current and emerging guidelines to improve patient safety and prevent poor healthcare outcomes by identifying, designing, evaluating, and mitigating risk.

NP Domain 6: Inter-professional Partnerships

Exhibits effective inter-professional communication and collaborative skills in the development and implementation of practice models, peer review, practice guidelines, health policy, standards of care, and/or other scholarly products.

NP Domain 7: Systems-Based Practice

Demonstrates an understanding of the healthcare system, including its organization, financing, policy, and regulation to influence future practice, healthcare policy and improve healthcare outcomes.

Domain 8: Informatics and Healthcare Technologies

Utilizes informatics and healthcare technologies to ensure the delivery of safe, high-quality, and efficient healthcare services in accordance with professional and regulatory standards.

Demonstrates integrity and accountability in developing an ethical professional nursing identity that is representative of the evolving values, ethical principles and characteristics of the profession.
