

Indiana State University, School of Nursing, LPN to BSN Track

Description of Ineligibility for Nursing Program

Transfer applicants who have completed a portion of a baccalaureate nursing curriculum (nursing and/or cognate courses) at another institution will be held to the same admissions, progression and retention requirements as matriculating ISU nursing students.

- 1) Failure of any three nursing pre-admission courses will result in ineligibility.
 - ENG 101 & 105 or ENG 107 - English Composition 1 & 2 (6 credit hours)
 - PSY 101 - General or Intro Psychology (3 credit hours)
 - CHEM 100/100L - Chemistry (4 credit hours)
 - BIO 231/231L & 241/241L - Anatomy & Physiology 1 & 2 (6 credit hours)
 - BIO 274/274L - Microbiology (3 credit hours)

- 2) Failure of any two RN courses within the last five (5) years will result in ineligibility for the ISU LPN to BSN track.

Exception: A student may be admitted to the LPN-BSN Distance Track, if the student attended a previous RN program, received a passing grade of C or better in all course work, but was unable to pass the comprehensive program clinical proficiency.

Important: A student may become eligible to apply to the nursing program again (5) years from the last nursing course / pre-admission course failure(s).
