### 2a Proposed Revision to Spring 2021 Academic Calendar

A revision of the Spring 2021 Academic Calendar is being sought to respond to COVID-19 concerns.

A key way for the COVID-19 virus to spread is via travel and interacting with new groups of people. The winter break between the fall and spring semesters is a time when many students, faculty, and staff travel and/or visit family and friends. Spring break is also traditionally a time when students, faculty and staff may engage in travel. Given the goal of maintaining our commitment to in-person and hybrid instruction, as well as to conducting work on campus, the proposal is to delay the start of the spring semester by one week and to eliminate spring break. Classes would start on January 19, 2021, and run without a break through the end of the semester. The semester would conclude on the currently scheduled date. These changes also require adjustments to other important dates such as add/drop deadlines, attendance and interim grade reporting, etc. These changes are reflected in the calendar below.

By delaying the start of the semester by one week we will ask students and faculty to selfquarantine for at least 10 days prior to returning to campus. The elimination of spring break will reduce travel away from, and back to, campus during the semester. Both of these adjustments will help reduce the likelihood of transmitting the virus to other members of the ISU community.

Input into this recommendation has been gathered from the President's Cabinet, Student Government Association, Staff Council, and Faculty Senate. In order to provide a full discussion of the topic, the President convened a joint meeting of the Cabinet along with the leadership of the three shared governance units. All expressed support for this proposal.
